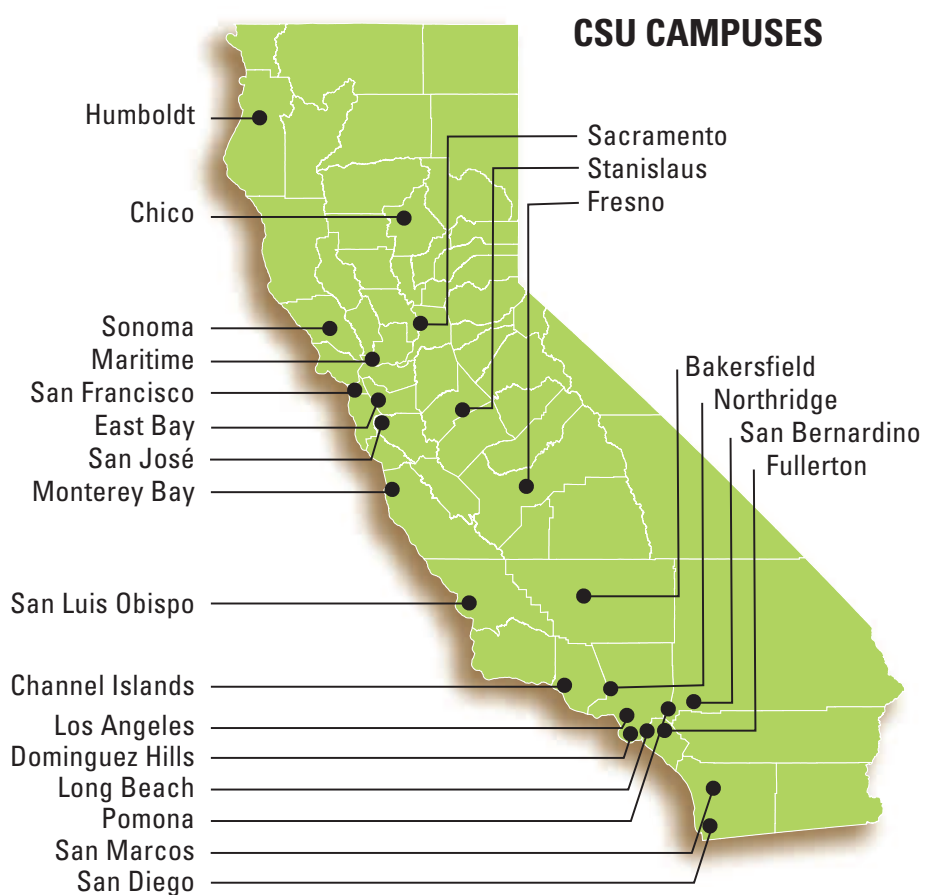
If you will be applying to the California State University (CSU) when you are a senior, please consider taking the Early Assessment Program (EAP).
